

- 14 year old boy
- Swelling at the shoulder since 10 days
- No trauma
- No tenderness, no clinical signs of inflammation
- Pediatrician thought of lipoma
- MRI: Cystic appearing lesion superficial at the deltoid muscle, probably subfascial location, with septations and septal enhancement, without nodular solid component
- What is the differential for this lesion:
 - Hematoma? (though no trauma history)
 - Infection? (though no clinical signs)
 - Ganglion?
 - Myxoma?
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
